

BOLD VOICES



The Ambassador Programme is an innovative annual online programme for students, teachers and parents to listen, learn and share their knowledge. With the aim to facilitate tangible, long-term change within their school and the wider community.

Student Reps

- 5 students OR 30 students (see options below) from Years 10, 11, 12 & 13.
- Students hand over to a new group of Reps at the end of each academic year.

Learning

- 10 x 90 minute live virtual seminars.
- Across the academic year.
- Held on weekday evenings.

OPTION 1: 5 students join the National Ambassador Hub. For their 10 live seminars, they join student reps from other participating schools.

OPTION 2: Create your own dedicated School Hub with 30 students from your school. Students will receive 6 live seminars as a group and will join the rest of the students from other participating schools for 4 live seminars.

Teachers

- To support Student Reps and facilitate integration across whole school.
- Recommend inclusion of a representative from SMT/SLT.

Learning

- 6 x 60 minute live virtual seminars.
- · Across the academic year.
- Held on weekday evenings.
- Join alongside teachers from other schools participating in the programme.

Parents

- To ensure key messages and support reach all parents.
- Recommend inclusion of a representative from Parents' Association.

Learning

- 3 x 60 minute live virtual seminars.
- Across the academic year.
- Held on weekday evenings.
- Join alongside parents from other schools participating in the programme.

All student, teacher and parent participants:

- Have access to the Ambassador Online Hub, including:
 - Recordings of seminars to watch again and catch up on.
 - Resources and key learning material from seminars.
 - Additional podcasts and recommended reading.
- Become members of the Bold Voices
 Ambassador community. Joining
 student reps, teachers and parents
 from participating schools across
 the UK to share ideas, best practice
 and collaboration.
- Take part in pre and post programme surveys and impact measurement.




