WHAT OUR CAMPS ARE ABOUT

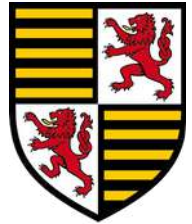

INFORMATION

- The camps are based on current social distancing rules and Covid guidelines.
