Code of conduct for spectators at school sport: COVID-19

At Warminster School, we strongly encourage and greatly appreciate support for our sports teams from family and friends. We have worked hard under National Governing Body rules and regulations to operate training and fixtures, and therefore ask that the following guidelines are observed by spectators and supporters at the current time. Please be aware that these guidelines **MUST** be followed whether watching fixtures or training sessions.

- In line with current Government guidance, all participants (pupil, school staff, match officials, volunteers, spectators etc.) should check for symptoms of Covid-19. If an individual is symptomatic and/or living in a household with a possible Covid-19 infection they should remain at home and follow Government guidance.
- All visitors must sign in at the specific pitch/astro; all names in their party and a contact phone number given. One member of the party only to be at the sign in desk.
- Ideally visitors will remain in their cars until a match or training session commences.
- Social distancing **MUST** be adhered to, 2-meter rule at all times.
- All visitors must provide their own hand sanitiser, and ensure it is used on arrival and at regular 20-minute intervals whilst on the school site.
- Only pupils and staff will be permitted onto the astro. All spectators must remain outside the fence line, adhering to social distancing regulations
- For cricket matches and training on New Fields & Cold Harbour, visitors must not be around the players area situated by the nets (New Fields) and the pavilion (Cold Harbour)
- Cricket spectators are asked to spread themselves around the boundary to watch, ensuring the 2-meter rule at all times.
- Toilets will be available for visitors, but please ensure only two people are inside at one time and respect social distancing where possible. Toilet facilities will be inside the TA Hall foyer

We are very keen for parents and visitors to come and support the pupils, but all the above must be adhered to at all times in order for us all to remain safe and allow us to offer sporting opportunities to the pupils

By signing in on match days you are agreeing to our Code of Conduct. Members of staff will be monitoring the situation and may politely remind you of the guidelines. We look forward to seeing you at our fixtures this term and beyond.
